What made you go?



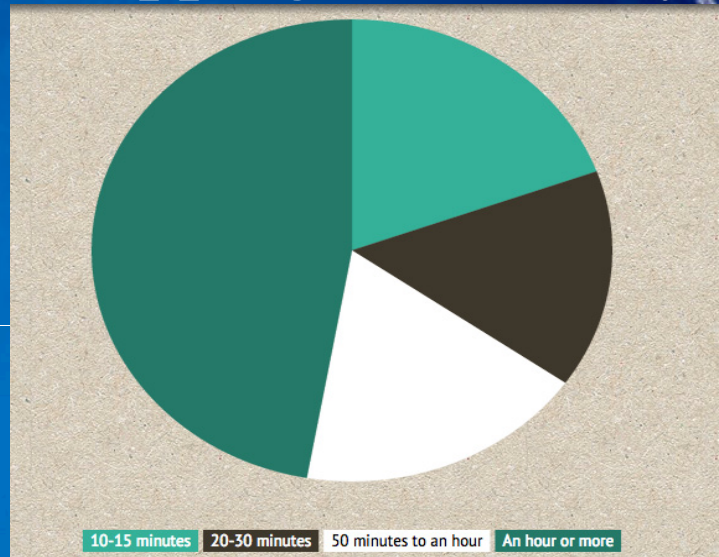
